Dear Humans,


I hope I didn't frighten you the other day when I bumped into you in my cave. I really wasn't expecting to meet any one there and it was a bit of a shock.




Photocopy on to card, cut out and use as a template. When you draw round the template ensure that your outlines extend across the edges of the paper at each side.

- Fold landscape A4 paper to make A5 portrait. Use to create a 4-page shaped book.
- Tape 2 x A4 landscape pages together to make a long strip, then fold to A5 portrait. Use to create an 8-page shaped book. Alternatively, if you have A2 paper fold this from landscape to A5 portrait to make 2 x 8-page books at the same time.



Photocopy on to card, cut out and use as a template. When you draw round the template ensure that your outlines extend across the edges of the paper at each side.

- Fold landscape A4 paper to make A5 portrait. Use to create a 4-page shaped book.
- Tape 2 x A4 landscape pages together to make a long strip, then fold to A5 portrait. Use to create an 8-page shaped book. Alternatively, if you have A2 paper fold this from landscape to A5 portrait to make 2 x 8-page books at the same time.



Colour and cut out the ears, then stick or staple them on to a card headband.
