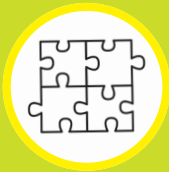


Common Schemas



CONNECTING joining and disconnecting resources such as Duplo®, train tracks or gluing materials together.



ROTATION fascination with spinning objects including rolling items, spinning and wheeled toys.



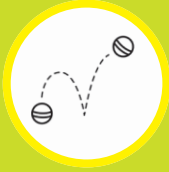
ENCLOSING building enclosures or boundaries around items or drawing borders around pictures.



ENVELOPING covering themselves or objects with fabric, posting objects, wrapping things up and covering hands/paper with paint or glue.



POSITIONING interested in lining objects up such as cars, people and blocks or arranging them into groups.



TRAJECTORY interested in dropping things, throwing objects, climbing up or jumping off objects.



ORIENTATION interested in putting objects or themselves in different positions such as upside down, on their side, looking between their legs or climbing to get a higher perspective.



TRANSPORTING moving themselves or objects from place to place, bringing objects to show adults and carrying toys around in bags/containers.

A handy way of remembering the schemas is the mnemonic:
CREEP TO T.
